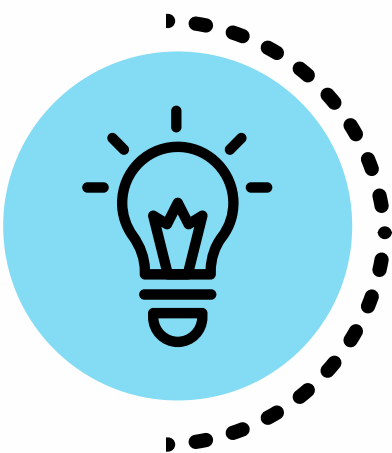


# CE IDEA COMPETITION TIMELINE

## 1 IDEA SUBMISSION

Submit your ideas to the EENCE coordination council by April 15th - for an initiative aiming to work on the network's defined priorities and address issues in the EaP region

## 2 ONLINE VOTING

All submitted ideas, that meet the technical criteria of the call will be available online for voting between **the 20th to 30th of April**

For accessibility reasons, the coordination council will be happy to receive email votes too. The voting will be open to the public and not limited only to network members

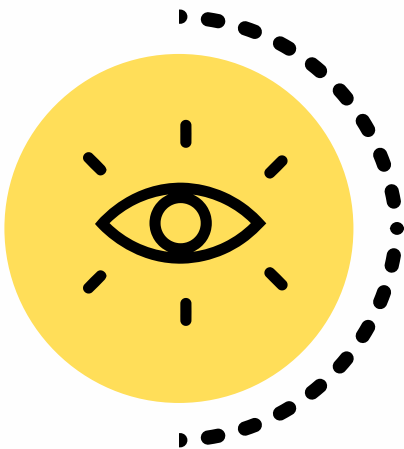
10 most liked ideas will be selected and authors will be notified before the 1st of May



## 3 PRESENTATION

The presentation of the ideas will be conducted online on the 5th of May, with the purpose of hearing out the authors and connecting them to possible partners from the region followed by a question and answer session

The option of participation in an online event will be available for greater public with the pre-registration required, and won't be limited only the network members

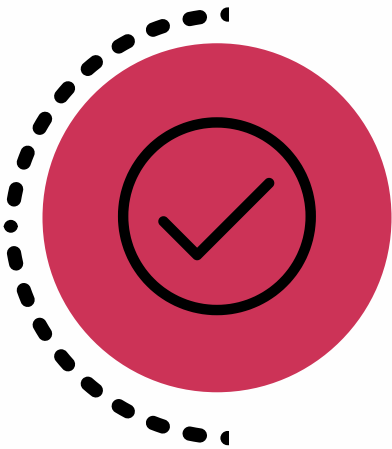


## 4 WORKING GROUPS

After the public presentation, the authors of the winning ideas will be invited to form a working group and develop their ideas in a more detailed manner together with WG members.

It is important for the WG to have at least 3 EaP country representatives and at least 5 members.

The work of the WG should be focused on implementing the initiative.



## 5 FULL APPLICATION

The WGs will get an opportunity to complete the full application with the **timeline, work plan**, and **detailed budget** together with the defined project partners, implementers and actors

**PLEASE NOTE: Initiative will be supported only if there are 5 identified actors from 3 different EaP countries**

The deadline for the full application is **the 1st of June**



## 6 IMPLEMENTATION

During the kick-off and implementation process defined project team is expected to work together as a working group, establishing good communication and partnership prospects to reach the project aim.

The deadline for all projects is **the 31st of October, 2023**
